

Location Monitoring Components and Technologies

*****A location monitoring component *MUST* be specified by the Court.*****

Curfew: Restricts the participant to their residence every day during a period specified by the Court or as directed by the pretrial services/probation officer.

Home Detention: Restricts the participant to their residence at all times except for employment, education, religious services, medical, substance abuse or mental health treatment, attorney visits, court appearances, court-ordered obligations, or other activities preapproved by the pretrial services/probation officer.

Home Incarceration: Restricts the participant to 24-hour-a-day lock-down except for medical necessities and court appearances or other activities specifically approved by the Court.

The specific type of technology (noted below) will be utilized to monitor the type of component (noted above) imposed by the Court. The Court can order a specific technology or permit the U.S. Probation and Probation and Pretrial Services Office to determine the technology to be utilized. The Court should always order a technology, or technology to be determined by the U.S. Probation Pretrial Services Office, and a component (two-part condition)

The U.S. Probation and Pretrial Services Office respectfully request all participants be ordered to pay the total cost associated with location monitoring; however, participants may be permitted to make partial payments, or the cost may be waived if so ordered. The U.S. Probation and Pretrial Services Office has an established protocol for determining a waiver of cost or amount of partial payment.

Virtual Monitoring (BI SmartLink) This is an application used via a smart phone. It uses the phone GPS technology in conjunction with facial recognition to complete a "check in" and report their current location Daily Cost: \$0.60	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitoring set curfew for low-risk participants. Medical/physical condition prohibit use of traditional monitoring equipment. Compatible smart phone required. Cost effective. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Does not provide constant monitoring during curfew period, as calls are made on a random basis. Participant required to respond to randomly generated check-in call 24/7. May interrupt employment or other activities.
Radio Frequency (RF) A transmitter device attached to the ankle which communicates with a receiver device placed in a specific location at the participant's residence. Daily Cost: \$3.68	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitoring set curfew/home detention/ home incarceration for medium to high-risk participants. Electronically detects a participant's presence at a specific location (typically their place of residence). Provides constant monitoring during curfew period. Alerts an officer when a participant leaves a specific location, returns to the specific location late, or tampers with the equipment while at the specific location. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Residence must be in range of cellular phone service to transmit data. Possibility of interruptions in cellular phone service which delays transmission of data. Does not monitor a participant outside the designated area. Violations cannot be detected when the participant is out of range of the receiver. Dependent upon participant maintaining electrical service at their residence.
Global Positioning Satellite (GPS) A device attached to the ankle which provides the ability to continuously monitor the participant's movements throughout the community. Daily Cost: \$4.23	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitoring high risk participants with identifiable risk, i.e., victims, co-defendants, witnesses, criminal associates; locations (schools, parks, bars, airports). Monitors movement throughout the community on a minute-by-minute basis. Ability to immediately determine a participant's whereabouts. Ability to require or prohibit the participant's presence at a specific location. Alerts an officer of a participant entrance to or exit from specific areas. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Requires cellular phone service to transmit data (specifically GPS points). GPS acquisition may limited/delayed when participants enter specific structures/areas. Dependent upon participant maintaining electrical service and charging their GPS tracker battery daily

Location Monitoring Special Condition Wording

Component

Participate in one of the following location restriction program components and abide by its requirements as the pretrial officer instructs for a period of XX days. Pay all or part of the cost of location monitoring based upon your ability to pay as determined by the pretrial/probation officer.

No overnight travel without Court approval.

One of the following must be ordered:

Curfew: You are restricted to your residence every day from XX to XX or as directed by the pretrial/probation officer;

or

Home Detention: You are restricted to your residence at all times except for employment, education, religious services, medical, substance abuse or mental health treatment, attorney visits, court appearances, court-ordered obligations, or other activities preapproved by the pretrial/probation officer;

or

Home Incarceration: You are restricted to 24-hour-a-day lock-down except for medical necessities and court appearances or other activities specifically approved by the Court.

or

Stand Alone Monitoring: You have no residential curfew, home detention, or home incarceration restrictions. However, you must comply with the location or travel restrictions as imposed by the court.

Note: Stand Alone Monitoring should be used in conjunction with global positioning system (GPS) technology.

Technology (must be ordered as well)

The defendant shall submit to the form of location monitoring technology, at the discretion of the probation officer, and abide by all technology and program requirements for a period of ____ days. The defendant shall pay all or part of the costs of participation in the location monitoring program as directed by the probation officer.

or

The defendant shall submit to the form of location monitoring indicated below, and abide by all of the technology and program requirements for a period of ____ days. The defendant shall pay all or part of the costs of participation in the location monitoring program as directed by the probation officer.
